My students and I created this form to facilitate conversations during our social language groups. I have printed these pages, glued them to tagboard, and created a poster that I've placed in my room. I can now easily refer students to these tips without using verbal prompts.



Tips for Having a Great Conversation!

- 1. Maintain appropriate eye contact
- 2. Always stay focused on the other person
 - 3. Have good body posture
 - 4. Face the other person
- 5. Ask the speaker questions about their topic

6. Make comments so that the speaker knows you are listening

- 7. Your voice should sound like you are interested in the conversation
- 8. Change the topic in a way so that your listener is aware of the next topic
- 9. Let the listener know that you are ending the conversation
